Job Description: Instructor

Primary Purpose:

To teach a group of Apprentices basic woodworking and boat building skills in an environment that also teaches respect and personal responsibility in a safe and nurturing community.

Responsibilities:

Duties of this job include, but are not limited to:

- Teach woodworking and boat building
- Teach shop safety
- Teach general work skills (punctuality, communication, focus, self-care)
- Teach seamanship, sailing, and rowing
- Teach restoration of old boats
- Fix and maintain machinery and tools
- Participate in extracurricular activities (sailing, boat trips, outings).
- Coordinate community service
- Coordinate jobs for three-day visitors
- Design and facilitate Chapel meetings
- Participate in weekly staff meetings
- Order and organize wood supply
- Order supplies as needed for shops
- Counsel apprentices on personal and interpersonal skills
- Greet visitors and give tours of facility
- General instruction in the use of wood as a building material
- Lead and/or organize after meal reflections
- Interview and participate in apprentice applicant selection
